

## SEAL Testing – Year 7 Intake 2018

If you would like your child to be considered for the SEAL Program the first step is to complete an application form. Application forms are accessible from the form on the back of the Fairhills High School SEAL brochure or download an application form [here](#).

A one-off payment of \$50 is required with the application form. This amount will be credited towards your voluntary fees for 2018 upon your child's enrolment at Fairhills High School.

Completed application forms must be forwarded to the school by **Tuesday May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017**. Forms are accepted in person, by mail or simply scan and email to [probin.ruth.c@edumail.vic.gov.au](mailto:probin.ruth.c@edumail.vic.gov.au)

Students then sit a formal exam designed by the Australian Council of Educational Research (ACER). The test has two parts: Verbal Reasoning and Non-Verbal Reasoning. These tests are designed to measure a student's learning potential rather than subject knowledge.

The Grade 6 testing date is **Saturday May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017**.

Testing will take place from 9am – 12pm in the C Block rooms of Fairhills High School.  
Further details will be emailed to you on application.

From this testing a shortlist of candidates will be established and selected students will be invited to attend an interview. First round offers will be made following the interview process.

In Term 4 all students who have enrolled in our Year 7 classes for 2018 will sit a Learning Pathways test. Limited second round offers may be made at this time. Second round offers will only be available to students who have formally enrolled at Fairhills High School for 2018.
